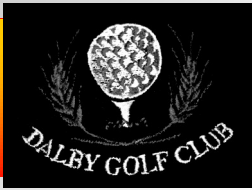

ALL IN ATTENDANCE VOTED TO SUPPORT THOSE NOMINATED AND ELECTED.

TREASURER REPORT

Craig accepted the position and commented on how positive the junior process has become over the past few months. He stated that he sees the newly appointed committee as a positive direction for the juniors and towards strengthening the Dalby Golf Club. After consultation with Alf Hockings with regards the past and present procedures for the juniors, Craig announced that by the next committee meeting he will develop a draft plan for the junior finances and allocation of funds for the coming year to ensure continued growth through a set of defined rules and regulations. He will be in consultation with Heath Garvey (Pro) and John Wicks (DGC Treasurer) during this process. Craig stated that an official junior golf bank account will be created immediately. The official bank account total will be presented at the next meeting within the first official Junior Treasurer's Report. He stated that the JDP funds to date is in a very positive situation for the few months of operation.

DALBY JUNIOR GOLF SHIRTS

Teresa Buckley presented the details of the Juniors shirts that are now in the ordering phase. She reported that all junior families are very positive about the emerald green, black and white polo custom made design. The pricing for the shirts at this stage are \$30 for members and \$40 for non-members. It was mentioned if there are families that require assistance with the financial cost of the shirts to see either Heath, Dave & Teresa or Craig in a confidential manner. All requests for assistance will be treated confidentially. The shirts will take a 4-5 week process. The shirts are to be worn on Saturday's during coaching, in competition and when representing in a team event. It is also required for safety reasons at the DGC so that Heath, the junior co-ordinators and DGC members are aware who the juniors are.

Teresa also mentioned that an 18 hole junior representative shirt for 12 juniors (a white version of the junior green shirt) is being sponsored by the company that DGC Member Mr Sid Capewell works for. The JDP thanks Ancon for their support with this venture. These shirts will feature their logo. The 18 hole juniors to receive this shirt must have signed the 'commitment pledge' that will be presented in the junior sign-on packs to be presented this month.

Individual and team photographs of the DGC Juniors will be taken by Renitta Flynn when the uniforms arrive to use for promotional purposes. All juniors will have to have a media release form signed prior to this event. The form will be given out with the junior sign-on packs this month.

FIRST AID KITS & SUNSCREEN

Teresa presented the need for first aid kits and sunscreen to be available on Saturday mornings and during team events in the travel kit, in case of an emergency. The idea was accepted by all junior committee members. Kellie Wenning is to follow up on first aid kits options. Karen White offered to donate a sunscreen pump pack. Karen and Kellie were thanked for their contributions.

SAND BUCKET REQUEST

Teresa and David presented a request on behalf of Brett Cain that the juniors present the DGC with 100 new sand buckets for both junior and men's / ladies use. The price of these are being investigated at this stage. Brett Cain has offered to rejuvenate the sand bucket stand if this request is accepted. The final price will be presented at the next committee meeting for further discussion. A sausage sizzle fundraiser will be held as the sand buckets fundraiser. All junior committee members are in favour of this proceeding.

COMMITMENT PLEDGE

The 18 hole junior commitment pledge was presented by Teresa and Renitta. Heath called for support for this pledge to support the juniors, the club and the financial aspect of the junior process. He stated that this type of requirement is present in most junior golf divisions. The commitment pledge outlines the expected requirements of the 18 hole juniors in relation to their involvement within, their support and commitment towards the Dalby Golf Club including their ability to request support for representative level golf events. This pledge will be presented in the junior sign on packs for those who have not already signed one. No junior can apply for financial support from the DGC or the JDP towards representative level costs unless this commitment pledge is signed and honoured. All present at the meeting were in favour of this commitment pledge.

CHRISTMAS RAFFLE

The first official fundraising event for the Dalby Juniors will be a Christmas Raffle. Teresa presented an idea that the juniors bring in items towards hamper packs to be created to combine with items donated by various DGC members. A fundraising team would need to be formed to co-ordinate these and to organise raffle tickets for the juniors to take home to sell as well as within the DGC over a 6 week time frame. All present at the meeting were in favour of this wonderful fundraising venture. Kerry Jiggins, Lauren Walkinshaw, Tammy Hope and Trish Steginga volunteered to co-ordinate the raffle process. JUNIOR SIGN-ON PACKS

Teresa and Renitta presented to the meeting the progress of the junior sign on packs. The sponsors involved were thanked. All sponsors will be acknowledged on a sponsors page within the junior newsletters and on the junior notice board. Teresa mentioned the items for inclusion are junior golf information handouts, player contact forms, commitment pledge for 18 holers, media release forms, etc.... relevant information for the junior within the Dalby Golf Club environment. Sponsor items include drink bottles, stickers, carry bags, golf balls & tees, pencil case packs, dinner vouchers at DGC, pens, pencils, golf books....etc... All very positive and exciting ! The items are now ready to collate into the packs and will be distributed to all juniors asap. - **Millmerran Junior Classic (October 11)** 9 & 18 hole Competition \$10 Nomination Fee/Lunch Up to 13 Dalby Juniors will compete. The JDP will sponsor this event.
- **Borneo Barracks Junior Classic (October 25)** 6,9 & 18 hole Competition. Fees to be advised. Numbers attending are to be determined closer to the date. Renitta apologised that Lawry Flynn will be unable to compete at the junior event as he will be travelling back from Brisbane on that day from the QLD Athletics Championships held during the week as BB changed their date from the 17th to the 25th before DGC were advised of the date changes.
- **Warwick Junior Classic (November 8th)** 4, 6, 9 & 18 hole Competition. Details to be advised.
- Teresa and David Buckley mentioned that Keely Buckley was invited to play in the Gertrude McLeod Event on the 26th October to represent the DGC Ladies which is an invitational event. Keely has also been invited to compete in the Greg Norman Junior Masters QLD event later in the year which includes international level players. The Buckley's will forward the details to Craig Brennan (Treasurer) to put forward for as a JDP sponsorship request.
- Heath, Teresa & Renitta clarified that the sponsorship allocation process is determined via the commitment pledge requirements, that the request put forward is for representative or junior competitions other than DGC and to be determined through the JDP committee process under the rules & regulations to be drafted by Craig Brennan (Treasurer) and voted on.

JUNIOR PROMOTION AND NEWSLETTERS

Renitta presented a few initiatives that will be included within the junior newsletters each month as a regular feature. A sponsors page or two will be created to promote those that support the juniors. Each month will also see a player profile section of one of the DGC members. Those attending the meeting also voted to include a junior member player profile each month. The October Issue will feature Mr Mike Peeck as the DGC member. Renitta will aim for a DGC Ladies member for the November Issue. Renitta asked that parents email photos through to her at fly94@harboursat.com.au for newsletter consideration / use when applicable. It was also encouraged that any juniors golfing news outside of the DGC be forwarded through as well. It is also encouraged that the newsletters be forwarded to their juniors schools when applicable to help with DGC promotion. Renitta explained that Paul Donnelly is the DGC designated email person to all DGC members and that she works in consultation with Paul. Jon Russell is the DGC promotions officer and Renitta will also work in collaboration with him when applicable. It was also mentioned that the DGC Website is a great and all newsletters can be accessed in the NEWS section at www.dalbygolfclub.com.au. Renitta stated that the feedback in regards to the newsletters and the website has been extremely positive and she will continue to ensure the success continues.

FINAL COMMENT

Craig and Teresa thanked Heath Garvey for his co-ordination of the FOOTY DOUBLES fundraiser which was a huge success. Over \$400 was raised to support the juniors. The winner was Mr Paul Buckley.

Teresa, David, Heath and Renitta reiterated that the Junior Committee process is all new and exciting and we are all working towards a common goal of supporting the junior golfers. The level of support over the past three months has been overwhelming as well as the juniors growth. The direction of the new JDP Committee will definitely promote the motto of 'supporting Dalby juniors golfing future today' !

A special mention is to be noted as after the meeting closed at 6.45pm Glen & Barb Evans donated a laptop to the JDP for the collation of juniors results and information records.
